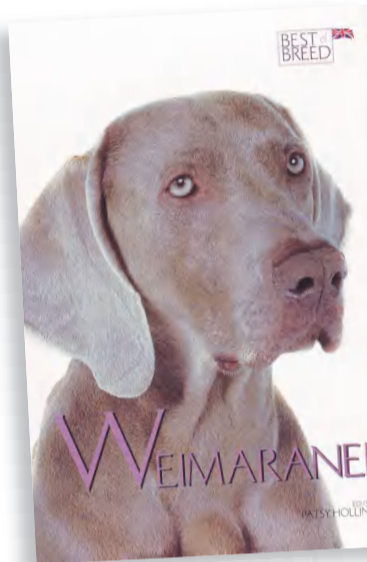

As well as handling over 30 Westie champions, he's also handled hundreds of champions in different breeds. Impressively, Geoff has judged at Crufts several times. Bull Terrier

Dr Harris has owned, bred and exhibited Bull Terriers since 1970 under the Brummagem affix. He is a recognised expert of the breed and a prominent raconteur of canine history. His published works are already viewed as classics and he has written numerous articles for worldwide publications. He currently resides with his Bull Terriers in New Mexico.

Border Collie

Judith Gregory has owned Border Collies for over 50 years. Not only in a showing capacity but originally she worked them in obedience, agility and on sheep. Judith has enjoyed ranking as Top Breeder in the UK five times in the last six years, as well as in countries across Europe. She bred the Border Collie Breed Record holder, Sh Ch Tonkory Palmerston at Fayken JW, who has 45 CCs. She is currently Border Collie Breed Representative to the Kennel Club.

Golden Retriever

Maurice Shortman (Bridgefarm) and his wife Judy acquired their very first Golden Retriever in the 1970s. Their first litter produced their first show bitch, Bridgefarm Harmony. The Bridgefarm stud dogs have sired Golden Retrievers that have achieved Champion status, along with Sh. Champion and JW winners in the UK, as well as many awards throughout the rest of Europe. Maurice has judged at Championship Show level all around Europe.

Boxer

Viv and her husband obtained their first male Boxer, Samantony Eye of the Tiger at Brubor (Bruno), as a wedding present in 1989. Their first ever bitch was a Crufts qualifier. After the tragically early death of their Boxer bitch, Katie, the couple had to start their line again. Since then they have had many successes in the breed. Viv has been judging since 1994 and is Treasurer for the British Boxer Club and also the Boxer Breed Council.

Staffordshire Bull Terrier

Alec Waters (Ashstocki) was involved in breeding and showing the breed for over 35 years, and his affix is known all around the world. Alec bred 7 UK Champions and 7 overseas Champions. He was a UK and international judge, having judged in America, Israel and South Africa amongst others. He even had the honour of judging the breed at Crufts in 1980. He was Patron for 15 years of the SBT Society of NSW and has

also served as an expert witness in defence of the breed in court.

Rottweiler

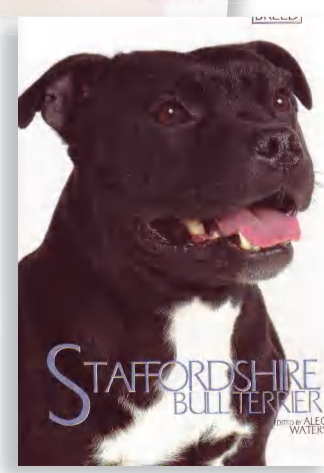
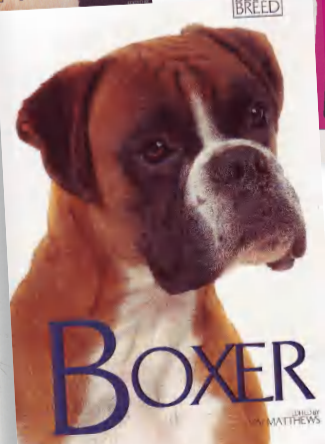
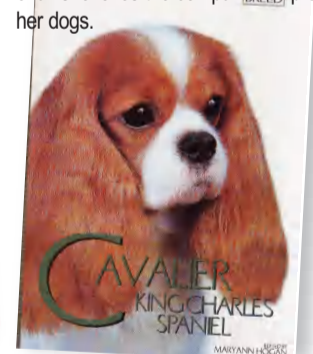
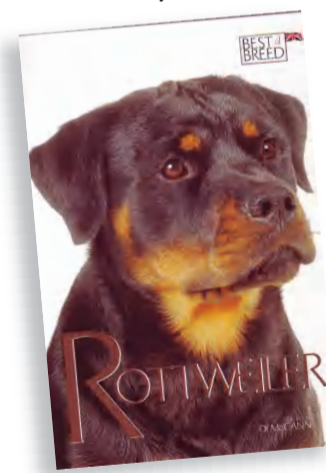
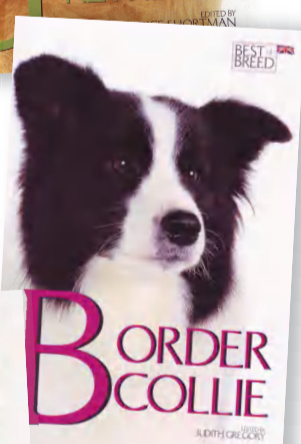
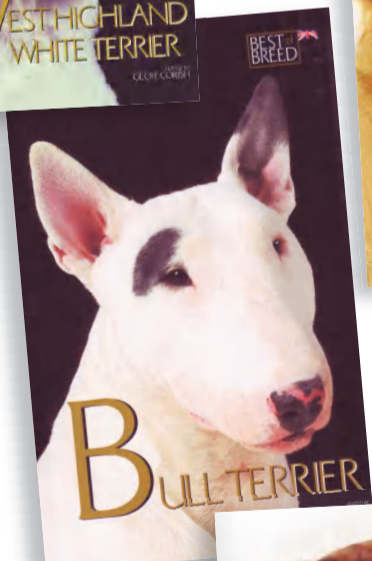
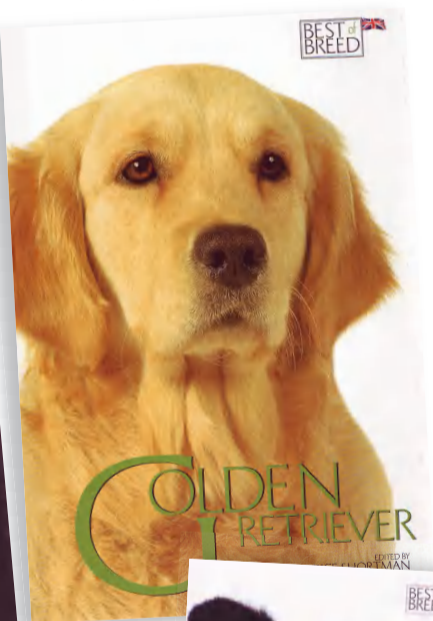
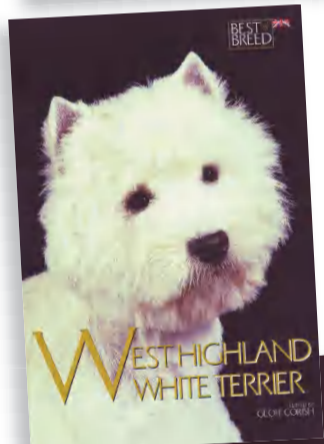
Edited by Di McCann

Before her retirement, Di competed in many canine disciplines. She owned Rottweilers for 21 years and has bred several litters with European bloodlines. He won a total of 12 CACIBS, 13 CACs, 6 CCs and was BOB at Crufts 2005. He remains the UK's first and only multi-champion.
