When not working Daryl divides his time between his focally and training when hot working Dary tuvides his time between his family and training dogs. A fellow American exhibitor described Daryl as a genuinely nice guy, who she saw a few years ago at a show in the US jump over a ring side barrier when a fellow exhibitor had a very nasty fall on concrete, he caught her dog, made sure she was ok and received first aid, later going on to handle her dog for her in the

Her win makes Stella the highest placed American bred dog to date at Crufts.

5 Seven years on the Internet and still going strong!

ur Dogs recognised the important of the Internet in the late 1990s and eight years ago in 2000 the decision was taken to establish an Internet presence.

Our first trials were launched in 2001. By the following year all breed note, show reports and news stories were being uploaded onto www.ourdogs.co.uk as the presses were rolling in Lincolnshire so that web browsers across the

word as well as in the UK could access them at the same time as the printed pages were dropping through the letterbox or being collected from the newsagent. It is a time consuming operation but our web team also found time to create our own online shop (rather than direct our site visitors to other outlets for their purchases) and our Interactive pages which feature the results of our reader surveys as well as photographs and even podcasts and videos. Since we went fully live there have been almost 9 million separate visits to the site which can sometime see 7 or 8 thousand visits in a single day. The great advantage of the site is that everything is stored in the right place. If you want to find a Crufts report from 2003 - or one from the Upper Hogsway

canine society last month for that matter - you just go to the date and all the reports are there. You do not have to struggle through a dozen pages of text in ten or twelve back issues of the paper to find them - they are available at the click of a button


Last year Our Dogs embraced the next phase of Internet technolo-gy by launching its on-line edition. This means that not only do you have the archive but each individual page is available on line as it appear in the paper.

In 2003 we launched our own message board (http://groups.msn.com/OURDOGSONLINE) which now has 1,400 members and is a site where you can publish your own photo-graphs and get involved in discussions ranging from vaccinations to judging appointments and discussions sometimes get very lively so it can be exciting as well as interesting. Over 25,000 messages have been posted since it began.

The Internet continues to evolve so Our Dogs has set up two sites on the social networking sites on Face book. One for Juniors can be found by going to the Facebook site

(www.facebook.com) and searching Our Dogs Young Kennel Association and the other by searching Our Dogs Picture Archive. If Dogs Picture Archive. If you are already a Facebook user you can immediately link in to your family and friends everywhere. Rest assured that OUR DOGS will continue to develop both in print and online in teening with all

online, in keeping with all readers requirements.
